## CATECHISTS AND CO-CATECHISTS NEEDED!

### OUR FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM IS LOOKING FOR CATECHISTS FOR OUR PROGRAMS FOR GRADES 1 THROUGH 8.

Catechists should be *confirmed Catholics* and *active in the worship life of Holy Family Parish*. Training and curriculum materials will be provided for catechists and co-catechists.

No experience necessary. Work with a friend or relative and help to share the traditions of the Church through faith formation. Our goal is to have two catechists per classroom. In order to accomplish this, we will need 48 volunteers.

The 2017/2018 Faith Formation program for grades 1 through 8 will consist of one introductory session, 12 catechetical sessions with students, and 2 family based faith formation sessions.

In addition to catechists, office help is also needed occasionally to help prepare materials to support our wonderful catechists throughout the year. A list of office volunteers will be compiled and as assistance is needed, an email will go out requesting volunteers.

Catechesis and religious education require the involvement of our entire faith community.

Not only are we called to provide a community that welcomes new members, but also to provide catechetical instruction to them. This is a wonderful opportunity to share the richness of our faith with the youngest members of our community. Please consider becoming a catechist or co-catechist.

## HOLY FAMILY CHURCH 2017/2018 FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM GRADES 1-8

Dear Families,

Ongoing Faith Formation is vital in the life of the Church, and the family is the primary unit of the Church community. The faith formation of our children must stem from the ongoing formation of our families. **Weekly attendance at Mass is essential to the practice of our faith.**

Holy Family is introducing a new **Faith Formation Program for 2017/2018**. Students in grades 1 through 8 will attend **12 catechetical sessions** on either Sunday morning, Tuesday afternoon, or Wednesday evening. These sessions will last 1 hour and 15 minutes. (When the registration forms were mailed in June, only two days and times were included - Sunday mornings and Tuesday afternoons. We are adding Wednesday evenings. If you have already sent in your registration form, but would like to take advantage of the evening classes for your children, please email Anne at [hfreducation@gmail.com](mailto:hfreducation@gmail.com).) Students and their parents will attend, together, **one introductory meeting entitled “Catholicism 101”** and **two family centered formation sessions**. Each week, the student and their family will have a **brief handout** to complete which helps connect the lessons students have learned with their day-to-day life. It is particularly important that you prioritize these sessions since there are fewer classes this year. Attached you will find the schedule of catechetical sessions for this year. One additional family centered session will be scheduled for each grade in the Winter/Spring of 2018. These family sessions are grade specific, so if you have children in different grades, you will need to come to multiple sessions. Arrangements will be made to care for children in your family who need to come with you, but are not participating in that evening’s session.

We recognize that our children spend a lot of time with textbooks, and we are proud to introduce a new curriculum this year without a handbook. Over the summer, we worked with several members of the parish community to design a program that will communicate the richness of our Roman Catholic faith at age appropriate levels. The 2017/2018 religious education program will stem from the Liturgy of Word and the rites, symbols, and magisterial teachings of the Church.

One of the contributors to this curriculum, Dr. Suzanne Guerin Herold, will be serving as our parish’s Director of Faith Formation. Dr. Herold holds a Ph.D. in Liturgical Studies and Sacramental Theology from The Catholic University of America. Over the past year, Suzanne has shared numerous insights on the liturgical history of our Church with the Holy Family community and other parishes throughout the diocese. Dr. Herold will be guiding our family based catechetical sessions, helping us to create a broader faith formation program in the parish, and serving as a resource for our catechists.

We look forward, with God’s blessing, to working with you and your family!

The registration deadline for this year's program is **September 8th**.  
**Regular CCD fees of \$120 for one child, \$220 for 2 children, and \$300 for 3 or more children are extended to August 10th.**  
The fees for returning families registering after August 10th are \$150 for one child, \$280 for 2 children and \$390 for 3 or more children.
